Key Stage Two (Years 3 – 6)

- Grammar
- Reading for information; Reading for Pleasure. Talking about reading.
- Writing stories; Research Projects
- Punctuation – Full stops, commas etc Paragraphs
- Visiting place of Culture and talking about them e.g. Museums; Art Galleries; Theatres; The River; Formby Beach; Crosby Beach.

- Using the computer as a learning tool – to Research, question and find out – great for Science, Geography, and History.

- Mathematical problems – related to time, measurement, money, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions, and decimals.
