Impact of Pupil Premium Spend 2014 – 2015

Closing The Gap

End of Key Stage Two Results

- 23 children in the Year 6 cohort
 - 10 Pupil Premium children
 - 13 Non Pupil Premium children
 - Overall results - 100% achieved level 4+ Reading.
 - 83% achieved level 4+ Writing.
 - 83% achieved level 4+ Maths.
 - Combined results – 78%.
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- 10 Pupil Premium children
 - Overall results - (10) 100% achieved level 4+ Reading
 - (7) 70% achieved level 4+ Writing
 - (8) 80% achieved level 4+ Maths
 - Combined results - (7) 70%
 - One Pupil Premium child achieved level 6 for Maths.
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- 13 Non Pupil Premium children.
 - Overall results - (13) achieved level 4+ Reading 100%
 - (12) achieved level 4+ Writing 92%
 - (11) achieved level 4+ Maths 85%.
 - Combined results - (13) 85%.
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Pupil Premium spend for 2014 – 2015 has had a positive impact upon raising standards in the school and narrowing the gap of attainment between Pupil Premium and Non Pupil Premium children. All children have made progress in their learning and end of Key Stage 2 results show that the gap in attainment is narrowing.

End of Key Stage One Results

- 24 children in the Year 2 cohort.
 - 8 Pupil Premium children.
 - 16 Non Pupil Premium children.
 - Overall results - (22) achieved level 2b+ Maths 92%
 (18) achieved level 2b+ Reading 75%
 (18) achieved level 2b+ Writing 75%.
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- 16 Non Pupil Premium children.
 - Overall results - 15 achieved level 2b+ Reading 94%
 - 15 achieved level 2b+ Writing 94%
 - 15 achieved level 2b+ Maths 94%.
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- 8 Pupil Premium children.
 - Overall results - 5 achieved level 2b+ Reading 63%
 - 5 achieved level 2b+ Writing 63%
 - 7 achieved level 2b+ Maths 88%.
