AIMS - To ensure that we use Pupil Premium to remove barriers to learning and ensure that all of our children achieve their full educational potential with skills for life.

To ensure that we make the best use of Pupil Premium funding and that our expenditure shows value for money.

Planned spend to ensure that the above aims are met.

1. To employ an additional Early Years Teacher - £43,552.00

To review our Early Years department and ensure that we raise standards from the start e.g. transition of vulnerable two year olds; seamless provision.

- To release Deputy Headteacher from full time class responsibility to – Team Teach Year 6, provide Booster Support for children in Year 5. To complete whole school monitoring.
- To employ an additional Teaching Assistant to increase adult ratio in order to support, monitor and liaise with agencies/families, for children in the Nursery and Reception. £9,915.00.
- To employ an additional Teaching Assistant to use flexibly throughout Key Stage One and Two to provide booster support for children identified in half termly assessment reviews. £11,989.00.
- To raise standards for all and minimise any gaps in the children's learning.

- To continue to provide Breakfast Club and Early Morning Club – contributions towards staffing and resources £6,000.
- To support our most vulnerable children during lunch times – to develop their social and emotional skills, to develop their health and safety skills, to develop team building skills. To provide male role models in the school. To employ sports coaches to create positive lunch times/readiness for class. £5,185.00
- To develop the children’s musical skills by ensuring all children in Year 4 have the experience of learning to play a musical instrument £1,500.
- To assist parents/carers of Foundation Stage children to help their children’s learning via Family Learning. £2,350.00
- To ensure that all children have access to a range of books, develop reading skills and reading for pleasure £3,400.
- To enrich the curriculum and Educational/Cultural experiences of the children via trips and resources. £5,000.00
- To develop the outdoor provision for the children in the Nursery to develop personal, social, emotional and physical skills. £9,317.00
- To provide additional resources to enrich learning in the Foundation Stage £2,000.
