Year 6 S.A.T's Week Monday 8th May – Friday 12th May

Next week the children will complete the national tests, as all Year 6 children will do throughout the country. Please make sure that your children are in bed early; get a good night's sleep and are in school early every day next week. I am sure that they will all do well and we are very proud of them.

First Holy Communion – Friday 19th May.

The children in Year 4 are making their First Holy Communion on Friday 19th May at 9 O'clock in Church. Parents are to take their child straight to Church and sit in the reserved bench. Staff will bring your child back to school after Mass to have a party with the rest of their classmates in school. Any donations of party food to help will be gratefully received. Summer Party Lunch day – Thursday 18th May
