Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope that you are all happy and well, enjoying the sunshine whilst it lasts. Please would you read the following information, some of which contains reminders of dates in the last few weeks of term? Thank you.

Hot weather (Reminder)

Please make sure that you cover your children with the highest sun factor cream available before they come to school. As the children will not be in and out of water, the protection will last long enough to cover lunch time. The children can wear sun hats and sunglasses if you wish – please make sure that their names are on both.

As always the children are encouraged to bring plain, still water into school in a bottle that has a sports cap (to avoid spillage onto other children’s work.) Please do not freeze the water as it melts and leaks water. Thank you for your understanding with this matter. When it is very hot we will provide additional water in school.

Picnic Themed Lunch – 23rd June

On Friday the children will be offered a Picnic lunch – all school lunches will cost £1.00. All children are invited to order a lunch, if your child does not usually have a school lunch then he or she is welcome to do so on Friday – please send £1.00 into school.

Tissues

Please can I ask that you provide your child with a packet of tissues? Thank you to the parents who already do this each week. It is very hygienic if your child is able to “catch a sneeze or cough” quickly in a tissue. Please teach your child how to wipe his or her nose to prevent germs from quickly spreading. Some very young children are fantastic at doing this and proudly show me their tissues.
