Magic Breakfast

Starting from Monday, there will no longer be the option for children to buy toast. Instead, we will be giving ALL children a healthy toasted bagel completely FREE OF CHARGE! This is being funded by the 'Magic

Breakfast' scheme, which looks to offer all primary school children a healthy breakfast to help build learning capacity.

Due to this, we are also making a change to what children are allowed to bring to school for snack at break time. **We will no longer allow children to have crisps, sweets or chocolate.** They are instead asked to bring in healthier snacks if they want to, although the bagel should be more than enough! These snacks may include; fruit, crackers, bread sticks, cinema style popcorn (not the coated ones), rice cakes and raisins. We would ask you not to send in cereal bars!!! We will continue to offer free fruit to all children in addition to the bagels...meaning they will definitely NOT go hungry!
