“The Barnaby book and bear are very popular. Such a lovely idea, and so nice to get the kids writing, reading and being creative. My daughter loved having him stay over.”




“I am extremely pleased with the support my child has received since starting in reception. He is now coming to the end of his first year at school and the progress he has made is excellent.”
