37 Questionnaires Strongly Agreed/agreed with all statements except Payment for After School Clubs – 28 questionnaires Strongly Agreed/agreed


This is what parents have said about the school in 2016/17.

“My children are very happy here and have a strong sense of belonging. They also feel part of the wider community – which is an essential (and often lacking) quality for our young people.”




“My children both enjoy school and are making very good progress.”

“We have had 4 children in St Leo’s and found the school very helpful and kind.”


“The nursery and staff have been outstanding this year with my son.”


