Your child's **free choice time** could be anything from baking to Lego. It is an opportunity to talk to your child. If they are building, ask them to design their own buildings first, talk about the height/length, who would live there? etc...

During baking, you could discuss measuring - more or less? Baking is a perfect chance to practise counting- how many cake cases? Etc...

Lego, playdough, dolls etc... helps to develop your child's physical skills - fine motor development is vital for writing. Fastening buttons and zips is also a great way to develop their finger muscles.
