#### Warld War I

## Key Vocabulary

**Air force**—Invented by the Wright brothers in 1903, planes played a vital role by the end of the war

**Animals**—Horses, donkeys and camels carried food, water, ammunition and medical supplies

**Bayonet**—A rifle with a knife attached at the end for both distance and close combat

**Gas mask**—A mask that provided protection against gas attacks (often lethal chlorine gas in the trenches)

Navy—Allied forces had hundreds of ships to protect the British and Empire's coasts Propaganda—Posters and leaflets were produced and distributed throughout the war to persuade people to join the army Rations—Ration cards were given out and only a certain amount of food was allowed per family

**Zeppelins**— these were giant airships, first used to bomb London in 1915 they were vulnerable to storms and attacks
