Key Concepts

Overview: The children take the role of authors to write the sequel to popular children's stories. They then create illustrations for their story and record themselves reading it in order to create an audiobook to publish online.

A sequel is a continuation from where a previous story ended.

A storymap helps to give an overview of the key events in a story.

Each page of a story needs to be planned.

Illustrations can bring a story to life and can be produced using technology.

Careful thought should be given to the layout and size of illustrations and text to ensure a high quality book.

All texts, including digital, should be carefully proof read.
