

Overview: In this activity, the children will learn to use presentation software and develop their keyboard skills in order to present their ideas. They will learn why it is crucial to present ideas in a well thought out format. The children will create a presentation about their own use of technology and why it is important we take a healthy balanced approach. Lastly, the children will have the opportunity to showcase their digital skills and independently create a short presentation about themselves.

- A variety of media can be uploaded to a presentation, for example, images, web links, data, sound and animation
