Key Concepts


Recap and Revise

- Through listening to a piece of music, it is possible to identify the instruments being played, the tempo, pulse and rhythm
- Everybody has their own response and thoughts regarding a piece of music
- Songs can be sung in unison
- Identifying and practising pulse and rhythm
- Different types of instruments can accompany a piece of music
- Voices and instruments can be used to improvise
- Everybody has their own particular favourite songs which they enjoy singing and moving to



Vocabulary

Recap and revision of vocabulary taught throughout the year.





<u>Skills</u>

Recap and revision of skills previous taught: **Listen and appraise**

- enjoyment from moving to music by dancing and marching,
- songs can tell a story or describe an idea.

Games

• Find the rhythm and pulse

Singing

- singing notes of different pitches
- different types of sounds with their voices (rap etc)
- comfortable singing position.
- start and stop singing when following a leader.

Playing

- treat instruments carefully and with respect.
- learn to play a tuned instrumental part that matches their musical challenge, using one of the differentiated parts (a one-note, simple or medium part).
- play the part in time with the steady pulse.
- listen to and follow musical instructions from a leader.

Improvise - using voices, clapping and instruments (20r 3 notes)

Compose - simple melodies using 2 or 3 notes **Perform**

- perform 3 songs they have learned
- add their ideas to the performance.
- record the performance and say how they were feeling about it.
