How we use this funding in our school

| Amount | How this Is Used |

| £16, 100 | We employ a Sports Coach to deliver quality PE to every class throughout the school at least once a week. Teachers remain with their class during these sessions in order to further develop their own delivery of the PE curriculum. |
| £1, 300 | SLA – School Sports Partnership. This year long partnership gives our children access to a wide variety of competitive sports ranging from football and athletics to golf and tennis. Children from years 1 to 6 are selected to take part in training sessions and competitive events. |
| £1, 750 | Mini bus. The mini bus is used to transport children to and from sporting events. Due to the geography of our school this is the best way for us to be able to participate in a wide range of sporting events across the borough. |
| £1, 680 | Swimming. All of our Year 4 children receive 4 weeks of swimming lessons throughout the year – 2 weeks in Autumn and 2 weeks in Summer. |

*Our Government Sports Grant does not cover the cost of all of our sporting commitments throughout the academic year. Therefore, school has subsidised this by £3, 060.
