Key Objectives

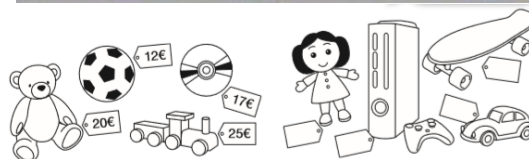
- Listen attentively to spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding.
