


### Animals including humans

### <u>Key Vocabulary</u>

Digestive system	parts in the body that break down and process the food that has been eaten.
saliva	watery substance in the mouth
Stamach	where food goes when it is swal- lowed
oesophagus	a muscular tube in the throat
intestine	the part of the digestive system after the stomach where nutrients are absorbed
digest	breaks down food so it can be absorbed by the body
omnivore	an animal that eat a diet of both meat and vegetables
carnivore	an animal that eats a diet of meat
herbivore	an animal that eats a diet of vege- tables or grass
canine	a pointed tooth used for eating meat
molar	a flat tooth used for eating vegetables
predator	an animal that hunts other animals for food
prey	an animal that is eaten by another
