The features of a seaside are sand, water, coast, bucket and spade, picnic, swimming and pebbles.

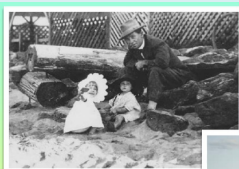
People in the past had different the clothes, shoes, hairstyles, chairs, buildings and cars.
