Amazing Activities

Use their print with fabric paint—print onto a piece of fabric

Key Concepts

The children will know 2 artists who have used printing in their work—Hokusai and Kwami. They will know where these artists live and what has influenced their printing work.

Children will use the landscape (rivers, mountains, sea) as a starting point for their print work. The children will experiment by producing different line drawings of a landscape.

Children will investigate the process of printing by painting onto a surface and taking a print of it with a piece of paper. Children to investigate colour mixing.

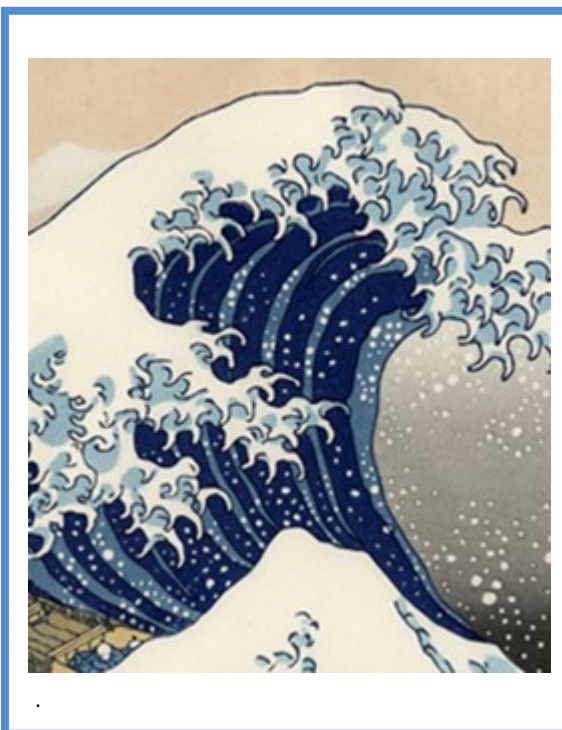
Children will decide which image they are going to use for their lino print before carefully using the correct tools to produce it. They will be aware that a simple image is easier to create and as effective as a more complicated one.

Children to investigate printing with their lino print, using different colours and colour mixing before producing their final piece of work.

Children will reflect and annotate their work at different stages in the process. They will self and peer assess and be able to identify ways in which they can improve their work.

Lino Printing

Challenge: To create a piece of art influenced by nature



Skills

- Use sketch books to collect ideas and develop a plan for a piece of work.
- Use taught technical skills to adapt and improve work.
- Draw familiar objects with correct proportions.
- Create different effects by using a variety of tools and techniques to produce a print.
- Experiment creating a mood, feeling, movement and areas of interest by selecting appropriate media and learnt techniques.

Key Vocabulary

print	A process of transferring a text or design onto fabric or paper
Line drawing	A drawing using narrow lines without any shading
Colour mixing	Mixing different colours together to create different shades or colours
lino	A floor covering made of materials including oil and cork
