Welcome to our latest newsletter. As we approach the end of this half term, there is a lot of information to share with parents. Please take the time to read this information so that you are aware of what is going to be happening in school for the final half term of the year.

Attendance

Our school target it 97% for the year. We need all classes to be above this target each week in order for us to exceed our annual target. Below are the current attendance figures for each class from September.

As you can see, all classes are below our target and sadly it looks like we will not meet our whole school target this year. However, we still need to work hard to get this as high as we can and to be above local and National attendance rates. We really need parents to support us with this when we return after the half term.

Changes to Breakfast and After School Charges - September 2024

Due to the increases in outgoings this year, we unfortunately have to increase the cost of breakfast and after school clubs from **September 2024**. The new costs will be:

Breakfast Club: £8 per week After School Club: £6 per day

We have compared our prices to other providers in the local area and we are still charging significantly less that those we have looked at. I have also had the prices from many other Knowsley schools and we are definitely charging less most of these too. I appreciate that times are difficult which is why we have kept our prices as low as we possibly can, this is also the first time we have increased prices since starting after school club in 2020.

Absence Procedures from September 2024

From September 2024, we will be issuing fines for any child who has more than 10 unauthorised absences (5 days as we have 2 sessions per day) from school in a 10 week period. We will only be able to authorise a medical absence with evidence form a doctor, chemist or medical centre.

The fine will be £80 per child per parent. This is a new legal requirement from September 2024 for all schools, therefore we have no choice but to issue the fines. I will post more about this at the end of the school year and again in September.

Ambition Week

We have had sports coaches, NHS staff, fire crew, police, engineers, beauticians, army personnel, ship's captain, hospitality hosts and even and ex LFC goalie!
